

# NOTICE OF RACE 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Regatta August 10-11th, 2019

### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in most current *The Racing Rules* of Sailing 2017-2020, and applicable class rules. With the exception that replica class sails that otherwise measure in to their applicable class will be permitted.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The series is open to members of MAYRA clubs and guests of Cooper River Yacht Club. The series is open to the following classes: Laser, (including Laser Radial), Sunfish, and GP-14. Any other one design class that can launch at CRYC and can preregister 3 boats may be added if desired.

A. Each boat shall display on her sail a number unique to her fleet and be clearly visible from the CRYC clubhouse roof. A boat is scored for the series by this sail number, which shall match that on her registration form.

B. This Regatta will also constitute the MAYRA Sunfish Championship. Only members of MAYRA clubs are eligible for this award. Sunfish Competitors not members of MAYRA and of a MAYRA club are only eliqible for fleet awards.

### 2.1 REGISTRATION

Registration will be available on line on the yacht club website prior to the regatta (www.cooperriveryc.org) and available the morning of on site at CRYC. Competitors must register their sail number, class, and skipper prior to racing. Crewed boats may register crew names as well. Preregistration is strongly encouraged.

Up to 6 races are scheduled over 2 days


## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Changes to this NOR or specific Sailing Instructions may be posted on the official bulletin board one hour prior to the start of the days racing, or earlier via club email/webpage.

## 7. VENUE

Races will be sailed in the waters of the Cooper River inside Cooper River Park Between Cuthbert Blvd. and Route 130

## 8. THE COURSES



| 1P: 1, 4, F          | 1S: 1, 4, F          |

Club courses above will be displayed on the roof of the clubhouse. All marks are to be taken to port on "P" courses and to starboard on "S" courses. The race committee will post the course on the course board on the roof. A number following the course code indicates the number of laps. For example, if the course is 2P2, a boat would round mark 4, then 1, then 4, then 1, all to port, then finish.

The starting line runs between the white pin mark on the north side of the river and the

flagpole on the roof of the clubhouse with the dark blue race committee flag. The identical white mark on the south side of the river nearest the clubhouse will mark the inner limit of the starting line. When approaching the line to start a boat shall pass between this mark and the pin mark. Please note the inner distance mark is not necessarily on the starting line. This same line serves as the finish line; boats must cross the line between the inner mark and the pin.

Other drop mark courses (orange ball) may be used at the discretion of the race committee; such courses will be defined at the skippers meeting.

## 9. SIGNALS

All signals will be sound signals or oral instructions from the roof of the CRYC clubhouse.

A three minute dinghy start sequence shall be used for all classes in accordance with Appendix S of the RRS

Individual Recalls will be signaled orally, Flag X will not be displayed

## 10. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System (RRS A) will be used for each class. 1 race will constitute a series

## **10.1 THROWOUTS**

- (a) When fewer than 6 races for a class have been completed, a boat's series scores will be the total of her race scores
- (b) When 6 races are completed for a class, a boat's series scores will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst score.

### 11. AWARDS

Fleets will have trophies for first, second, and third place. Top MAYRA Sunfish will also receive the MAYRA Championship awards for the class, awarded at MAYRA Dinner.

#### 12. BOAT STORAGE

Boats may be stored at Cooper River Yacht Club in our gated member yard. Contact the club if you wish to drop off your boat prior to the regatta.

#### 13. HOUSING

The Crown Plaza Hotel, located neat the Cuthbert end of the lake, has rooms available.
